Information on browsing and the use of cookies on the site

BravoSolution S.p.A., operating as "JAGGAER", provides, pursuant to European Regulation 2016/679 (GDPR) and current national legislation, information regarding the processing of data of users/visitors browsing the website <u>www.autostrade.bravosolution.com</u> (hereinafter referred to as the "Website"). To this end, this page describes the procedures for managing the Website in relation to the visitors.

The pages of the Website may contain links to the websites of other parties, to which, however, this information does not apply. Therefore, this information only applies for the website <u>www.autostrade.bravosolution.com</u> and not for any other websites that the user may enter via links.

1. DATA CONTROLLER

The Data Controller is BravoSolution S.p.A., operating as "JAGGAER", with registered office in Bergamo, via Canonici Lateranensi 1, and operating office in Milan, via Rombon 11.

The Data Protection Officers (DPO) are John Lawlor and Alexandra Viatteau, the latter having delegated authority for European matters.

2. TYPES OF DATA VOLUNTARILY PROVIDED BY USERS/VISITORS, AND PURPOSES

No personal data is acquired by the Website unless voluntarily provided by the user/visitor. If users/visitors connecting to the Website send their personal data in order to access certain services, or to submit requests by e-mail, this procedure only involves common data that will be processed exclusively to reply to the request or for the provision of the service.

2.1 COOKIE POLICY

A cookie is a short string of text that is sent to your browser and possibly saved on your computer; this generally occurs every time you visit a website. Each cookie is unique for the browser and device used to access the Website; generally, cookies are designed to improve the operation of the Website and the user's experience when using it.

BravoSolution collects technical information on the Website users' data.

Specifically, the IT and telematic systems and software procedures used to operate the Website acquire specific data during their standard operation, the transmission of which is implicit in the use of web communication protocols or is useful for better management and optimisation of the system.

This data is used for the sole purpose of obtaining anonymous statistical information on the use of the Website in order to check its proper functioning.

BravoSolution does not use cookies to transmit personal information; indeed, cookies are used in an aggregate manner and do not lead back to the user's identity, but allow monitoring the browsing habits of Website visitors, with the sole purpose of improving the service offered and making browsing safer and more efficient. On www.autostrade.bravosolution.com, cookies are used according to the following purposes and classification.

2.1.1 System or Technical cookies

Technical cookies are used to enable the best quality of use of the Website according to the characteristics of the browser used on your computer or on any other Internet tool.

These cookies enable the user to browse the Website and use its functions, e.g., to access secure areas of the site.

Lacking these cookies, the Website may not provide the services of authentication and proper functioning of the Website.

Cookies are not always defined by BravoSolution: in some cases, they are automatically generated and used by the software platforms used.

However, they are intended for the sole purpose of the general operation of the Website.

2.2 HOW TO DISABLE COOKIES FROM YOUR BROWSER

Users/visitors can change their browser settings to disable cookies or to be notified that cookies are being sent to their device. Users/visitors may refer to the instruction manual or help screen of their browser to find out how to adjust or change their browser settings.

If you choose to disable all cookies, the necessary, functional and performance cookies will also be blocked and this may cause troubles while browsing the Website.

3. DATA PROCESSING METHODS

Personal data will be processed, in compliance with the regulations in force, through IT and telematic tools and by implementing procedures strictly related to the aforementioned purposes, so as to ensure the confidentiality and security of the data.

4. DATA RETENTION PERIOD

Personal data of users/visitors will only be stored for as long as necessary for the purposes for which they are collected in compliance with the principle of minimisation pursuant to art. 5(1)(c) of the GDPR.

5. DATA RECIPIENTS

Within BravoSolution, only the persons tasked with the processing by the Data Controller and authorised to perform the processing operations within the scope of the aforementioned activities may acquire the personal data provided.

Personal data may be disclosed to third parties who are required to process the information for the same purposes as those set out in point 2 above, and who are, for this purpose, appointed as "Data Processors".

The full list of persons appointed as Data Processors is available from the DPO of BravoSolution. Under no circumstances will the personal data of users/visitors be disseminated.

6. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

Articles 15-22 of European Regulation no. 679/2016 allow Data Subjects to exercise specific rights; Data Subjects may obtain from the Data Controller: access, correction, cancellation, restriction of processing, revocation of consent as well as portability of data concerning them.

Data Subjects may also object to the processing. Where the Data Subject exercises the right to object to the processing, the Data Controller reserves the right not to process the request, and thus to continue processing, if there are compelling legitimate grounds for processing that prevail over the interests, rights and freedoms of the Data Subject.
