

Autostrade per l'Italia and accessibility

Accessibility is understood as, "the ability of information systems, including websites and mobile applications, in the forms and to the extent that the state of the art permits, to provide services and information that can be used without discrimination also by persons who, because of disabilities, require assistive technologies or special configurations" (art. 2, paragraph a, Law 4/2004).

A website is therefore accessible if it provides information that can be used by all users, including those with physical, technical or environmental limitations.
